The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) will host a Control Strategy Symposium at its Diamond Bar headquarters to provide an open forum on emission reduction strategies. These strategies will be analyzed and considered for potential inclusion in the 2016 Air Quality Management Plan (AQMP) currently under development. The 2016 AQMP involves an integrated planning process through collaboration with government agencies and non-government stakeholders. Demonstration and commercialization of near-zero and zero emission technologies are crucial to achieving the 2016 AQMP air quality goals.

Panels of experts will speak on specific technologies and control concepts followed by questions from panel moderators and the audience. The symposium is free of charge and open to all interested attendees. RSVP is not required.
