Funding Now Available for Air Filtration Systems at Public Schools Within AB 617 Communities



Funding available to public schools for air filtration installation and maintenance projects



Air filters reduce exposure to particulate matter and other harmful pollutants



Up to \$13.7 million available



Up to 100% of cost covered



Eligible schools must be within an AB 617 community

Carson West Long Beach San Bernardino

- South Los Angeles
- Southeast Los Angeles
- Eastern Coachella Valley

Eliaibility:

- Must be a public school
- ✓ Must be located within an AB 617 Community.
- Must meet federal, state, and local requirements

Applicants must submit:

- A project description, including the number of classrooms, the number and type of filters requested, the use of subcontractors and other information
- A project budget, including the cost of installation, maintenance, and other factors contributing to the project cost
- ✓ A project schedule describing key milestones and completion dates
- ✓ Other submittal requirements detailed in the program announcement



Applications are due by December 20, 2024, by 3PM

Replacement filters

- On September 6, 2024, the Board approved the AB 617 Public School Air Filtration Program
- Public schools and school districts located within AB 617 Communities and their vendors are eligible to apply for:
 - High Efficiency Particulate Air (HEPA) filtration systems, and



- Up to \$13.7 million in Community Air Protection incentive funds is available for the installation and/or maintenance of HEPA filtration systems
- Staff has conducted outreach to eligible school districts and vendors
- Applications are due by 3 pm on December 20, 2024
- Staff anticipates to begin awarding contracts in Spring of 2025

Climate Pollution Reduction Grant INVEST CLEAN



- Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) created \$4.6 Billion U.S. EPA Climate Pollution Reduction Grant Program (CPRG)
- \$500 million award to the South Coast AQMD
- INVEST CLEAN Infrastructure, Vehicles, and Equipment Strategy for Climate, Equity, Air Quality, and National Competitiveness
- Develop climate action plans and implement projects to:
 - Reduce air pollution
 - Support jobs
 - Greenhouse gas (GHG)emission reductions and community benefits
 - Address environmental justice



INVEST CLEAN Four Incentive Measures



Heavy-duty Charging Infrastructure

(Approx. 1,020 chargers) \$191 million



Class 8 Trucks and Last Mile Freight Class 4/5

(Approx. 70 Class 8 & 750 Class 4/5 trucks) \$84 million

(Approx. 60 CHE) \$26 million



Locomotive Pilot Project

(Approx. 18 locomotives) \$199 million







The current sensor network in SBM consists of 5 AQY sensors at locations selected based on community input.

- Supplement fixed monitoring station
- Provide real-time data access and visualization
- Provide tools for community education and engagement in air monitoring




