SCAQMD staff has reviewed the Negative Declaration for the above-named project. The lead agency states on page 14 of the report that "the proposed project's construction-related air quality impacts would be negligible" and therefore not significant. The lead agency does not provide any data to substantiate this statement.

Without this data, the lead agency cannot conclude that the proposed project's air quality impacts will not be significant.

SCAQMD staff recommends that the lead agency use the URBEMIS 2007 model on [www.urbemis.com](http://www.urbemis.com) to estimate the proposed project's air quality impacts and include the construction and operational emissions tables in the Final report and attach the output printout as appendix to the Final ND.
