<u>Maintenance of a Wireless Telecommunications Facility Project at 10401 Winnetka Ave.</u> and 20121 Devonshire St.; Chatsworth-Porter Ranch (NG-15-014-PL; ENV-2014-1479)

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) staff appreciates the opportunity to comment on the above-mentioned document both as a commenting agency and a responsible agency. The following comments are meant as guidance for the Lead Agency and should be incorporated into the Final Mitigated Negative Declaration.

In the project description, the Lead Agency proposes installation, operation and maintenance of a 60-foot high unmanned wireless telecommunications facility disguised as a pine tree. The project will contain 12 eight-foot long panel antennas in three arrays, 24 remote radio units located behind the panel antennas, one two-foot diameter microwave, one GPS antenna, and one diesel generator. Since the proposed project includes a diesel-fueled generator, a permit would be required in accordance with SCAQMD rules including Rule 1470 – Requirements for Stationary Diesel-Fueled Internal Combustion and Other Compression Initial Engines and Rule 1110.2 – Emissions From Gaseous- and Liquid-Fueled Engines if it is rated greater than 50 brake horsepower (bhp). If there are permit questions concerning the generator, they can be directed to Engineering and Compliance Staff at (909) 396-2315.

Please provide the SCAQMD with written responses to all comments contained herein prior to the adoption of the Final MND. SCAQMD staff is available to work with the Lead Agency to address these issues and any other air quality questions that may arise.
