- Air filtration systems
 - One school funded by EPA Grant 109

 - AQMD is providing technical assistance
 - Completed projects
 - ❖ Jurupa Valley High School – December 2011
 - ❖ Ruben Campos Community Center – April 2012
 - San Bernardino City USD Projects
 - ❖ Ramona Alessandro Elementary School (Grant 109) – completed in July
 - ❖ Mt. Vernon Elementary School – completed in July
 - ❖ Arroyo Valley High School – to be completed in August
 - ❖ Lytle Creek Elementary School added – installation not yet scheduled

- **UPS Truck Replacement Project**
 - UPS electrical infrastructure upgrades will be completed in time for first new trucks
 - First delivery of electric trucks has been delayed until the end of August 2012 due to changes in truck specifications requested by UPS
 - Some old trucks already identified for scrapping as new trucks are delivered

- Simple, easy to use
- Fill in basic information
 - Option for system to 'remember' you
 - Can be anonymous
 - Option to attach photo or video
- Automatically sends confirmation, alerts staff of complaint, and records in our database
- Ability to track status of complaint online
- Working on Spanish translation
