DIAMOND BAR – On Saturday, January 15, 2022, the South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) will virtually host the 9th Annual Martin Luther King Jr. Day of Service event celebrating Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.'s legacy promoting advocacy for justice, equality and equity.

This year's celebration, "Living, Dreaming, Believing in a Clean Air Future" focuses on how each of us can work for cleaner, healthy air to breathe, especially for our environmental justice communities most impacted by air pollution.

- **Dr. Marcus Goodloe**, author of "KingMaker: Applying Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.'s Leadership Lessons in Working with Athletes and Entertainers" will deliver an inspirational speech.
